July Biographies: 1] Poet Henry David Thoreau born on 7.12.1817 in Concord, MA. After graduating from Harvard, he taught in Public school for 2 weeks & quit when they demanded he use corporal punishment on students. He opened a school with his brother John & taught Louise M. Allcott. He closed the school when John died & worked in his Dad's Pencil Factory. After working as a carpenter, mason, & surveyor, R.W. Emmerson told him to keep Journals of his Poetry & writings. Emmerson let Thoreau build a Cabin in his 14 acres on Walden Pond. Thoreau wrote “Walden, Life in the Woods” & 14 Journals containing over two million words. In 1862, Thoreau died of tuberculosis, which he had since college.
2] The 2nd President's son, John Quincy Adams was born on 7.11.1767 in Braintree, MA. John, a lawyer & politician, spoke 9 languages & was known for his anti-slavery advocacy as a Senator. As the 6th US President, Adams enacted federal funding of an interstate transportation system. He increased US trade with foreign countries. The only retired President to serve in House of Representatives, John served 9 terms & died in office.
