JUNE BIO: President George H.W. Bush was born in Milton, MA on June 12, 1924. He was a US Naval “Torpedo Bomber” Pilot & won the Distinguished Flying Cross Medal when he was shot down during WWII. After George married Barbara & graduated from Yale, he moved to Texas to start in the OIL Business. Bush served as a US Representative for Texas, UN Ambassador for Nixon & Head of CIA under President Ford. In 1988 he was elected Vice President under Ronald Reagan for two terms. In 1989 G.H.W. Bush became the 41st President with the promise “No new Taxes.” In 1993 he lost the presidency to Bill Clinton & decided to retire from Political life. But before he died at age 94 in 2018, George “H.W.” was a very happy Father to see his son George W. Bush become the 43rd US President in 2000.**
