Grange Month Biographies of 2 Founders: Oliver Hudson KELLEY (B:1826 in Boston, MA) Educated in Boston public schools, Oliver's 1st job was as a reporter for Chicago Tribune. Then Kelley ran his Minnesota Farm with the 1st reaping machine & the 1st frame barn. In 1864, Mr. Kelley, became a clerk in the US Dept. of Agriculture & was selected by President Johnson to survey agricultural conditions in the Southern states following the Civil War. That's when Kelley conceived of a Farm Family Fraternity that could unite all across America (Patrons of Husbandry).

Caroline Arabella HALL (B:1838 in Boston, MA) Oliver Kelley's neice, Ms Hall was his Secretary, personal Assistant, & lived with the Kelley Family. She said; "Your organization will not succeed unless you give an equal place to women" & was influential in forming the Grange as a Family Fraternity with women having equal rights. In 1915 at Oakland, California, the Assembly of Demeter voted unanimously to insert a page in the Sacred Record of the Order, recognizing Ms Hall as a Founder of the Order of the Patrons of Husbandry. [The 8th Founder]
